## What About Those Ears?



### Ears the scoop...

The LaMancha ears are a result of a strongly inherited genetic trait. The small ear evolved from a doe that was born into the dairy goat herd owned by Mrs. Eula Fay Frey of Oregon. Mrs. Frey believed it had a European ancestor that may have been imported into Mexico and then brought into California by the Spanish-Mexican people. This first doe was named "Peggy" and proved to be an outstanding milker, and became the mother of what is now the American LaMancha. Each generation has been bred to the best bucks available of the other leading breeds until what we now know as the American LaMancha was established. The current breed standard for the LaMancha ear is as follows:

**Gopher ear:** An approximate maximum length of 1 inch, but preferably nonexistent, with little to no cartilage. The end of the ear must be turned up or down. This is the only type ear that will make bucks eligible for registration.

**Elf ear:** An approximate maximum length of 2 inches is allowed. The end of the ear must be turned up or turned down, and cartilage shaping the small ear is permissible.

## Our Programs:

**\*All American Program**— Open to all members who own a LaMancha that placed 1st or 2nd in an ADGA-sanctioned show for the current year. This is a recognition program for some of our nation's finest LaManchas.

**\*ALC Production Awards**— Open to all members who own a LaMancha that has been on DHIR milk production testing through March 1 of the current year. Awards are given based upon the quantity of milk, butterfat, and protein produced.

**\*ALC Dam/Sire Recognition Awards**—Open to all members who own a LaMancha sire or dam that has met the criteria listed on the ALC website for both production & linear appraisals for a qualified sire or dam. Multiple awards are given based upon a variety of criteria.

**\*ALC LaMancha Specialties**—LaMancha Specialty Shows provide the opportunity for the LaMancha dairy goat to be promoted at the regional level, while at the same time recognizing outstanding LaManchas within the breed. ALC Rosettes are provided for each sanction. A Best Udder medal is also awarded.

**\*Herd Recognition Award**—ALC members have the opportunity each year to nominate a herd they feel has had a significant nationwide impact on the advancement of the LaMancha breed to receive this one-time award.

**\*Youth Scholarships**—The ALC is proud to sponsor the Bob Webb Memorial Scholarship for high school graduating seniors, and the Ray Engeman Memorial Scholarship for college students.
